ENVOI

The *filoque* clause caused the great schism between the Eastern and Western Church – one tiny little word responsible for bloodshed and disunity for centuries. One of the rather more minor but irritating innovations of the Common Worship lectionary was the insistence on substituting the word 'of' for 'after' in the Sundays that follow Easter. It was done to try to remind us all that the great Easter feast outlasts the long Lent that precedes it, and fills the Church's heart and soul with alleluias until the feast of the Ascension. If you are wondering, therefore, if it's Easter 3 or Easter 2, it's one or the other, depending on whether you are 'of' or 'after'. Confused? Well, alleluia anyway.
